Registration: Membership forms are available in the clubhouse, can be downloaded from our website, or will be sent by post or e-mail (if requested) and should be returned with annual subscription for 2012 (€ 100 for first child - € 70 for siblings).

Coaching: Schedules may be changed to suit the numbers in each age group and coach availability. At present training is as follows: -

Under 9s and 11's (We have a lower age limit of 7 years of age)	Monday 4.30 p.m. to 6.00 p.m.
Under 13 & Under 15	Tuesday at 5.00 p.m. to 6.30 p.m.
Under 17 (Adult Nets)	Thursday at 6p.m. to 8.00 p.m.

We will also be introducing extra coaching sessions on weekends depending on whether there are games for the teams. For example under 11's could be playing at Phoenix and Under 9's could have coaching at the same time. Your Team Manager will make these arrangements when the season commences.

The club provides playing equipment.

Matt Lunson & Willie Dwyer and have been appointed as club coaches with specific responsibility for coaching at Phoenix this year.

Matches: We have the following teams this year :-

- Three Under 11 teams (Boys & Girls)
- One Under 11 Girls team
- Two Under 13 teams (Boys & Girls)
- One Joint Team (with Nth. Kildare C.C.) for Under 13 Girls
- One Under 15 team
- One Under 17 team.

Normally U 11 and U13 matches are at weekends starting at 10:00 a.m., however there will be some mid-week matches. Under 15 and Under 17 are mid week matches at 1 p.m.

Dear Parent / Guardian,

We ask you to take a few minutes to read through the club rules for our youth section, **before** you register your child for Phoenix CC. When your child joins the club you are agreeing to abide by the rules.

Because of the very welcome increase in playing numbers we are continuing to make significant efforts to promote and encourage our children's cricket this season.

We aim to have more games, more coaching/training, more fundraising evenings (BBQ's weather permitting etc).

The annual subscription for 2012 is €100 and €70 for siblings. This includes the provision of the new Phoenix CC playing gear (Phoenix Cap, Shirt and Trousers). If your child has the playing gear from previous years we are introducing additional equipment in our club shop that will be provided free with your membership subscription. This includes cricket shoes, training tops etc.

Family membership, at a very reasonable rate, is also available for those adults who would like to play cricket too!

On the Youth Committee we actively encourage parents to avail of this scheme where it is appropriate. We consider all parents to be members of the club and this scheme will give those who want to avail of membership (even pavilion membership) a chance to have their voice heard in how the club is run. One family membership is one vote in all the clubs meetings (AGM's etc)

The attached rules are necessary for your child's safety and welfare and are part of the Health and Safety requirements of any sports club. If you have any queries about them please speak to our Youth Chairman, Albert Fahy, who can be contacted on **(087) 244 2222**.

Phoenix CC Youth Section Rules

1. (a) Inappropriate language or behaviour in relation to any club member, particularly coaches/team managers and other youth members are **unacceptable** at any time.
(b) Good manners and appropriate behaviour is **expected** at all times. Your child must listen to the coaches/ team managers at all times.
2. All children **must** attend coaching sessions and matches in their Phoenix Playing Gear. This is to promote a sense of teamwork amongst the children and give all kids a Phoenix CC "identity".
3. Appropriate protective equipment **must** be worn during all matches (and during practice sessions as instructed) i.e. when batting pads and gloves, and in addition, when batting against a hard cricket ball a helmet (and protector for boys) must be worn.
4. A Parent or Guardian **must** attend coaching sessions and matches with their children. This is a new requirement this year and we are asking for everyone's assistance in this regard rather than having to ask Team Managers to police this requirement.
 - (i) We want to create a supportive atmosphere for all children during games
 - (ii) For safety reasons a parent/guardian **must** attend in case of injury to their child.
 - (iii) The club cannot be asked to monitor children's behaviour at the expense of other children's coaching requirements.
5. The coaches/team managers and managers cannot be responsible for children straying from the cricket grounds.
6. At the end of a coaching session or match parents should collect their children at the Pavilion area
7. Use of mobile phones by players is **not** permitted during coaching sessions and matches and they must be switched off at all times.
8. Phoenix CC is not liable for any loss or damage to your child's personal property if it is stolen from the club. Any personal property brought to the club by your child is entirely at your own risk. Coaches/team managers are not responsible for any personal property belonging to your children. Children who have their own playing equipment may use their own at matches or practice. They **may not** lend or borrow equipment to/from another player. The club provides equipment for youth players who do not have their own.
9. Food or drink **must** be consumed before or after coaching sessions and matches, not during them except at the discretion of the coaches/team manager's e.g. medical reasons, warm weather. Any waste belonging to your children must be placed in the waste bin in the club or taken away with them.

Phoenix Cricket Club will not permit photographs, video images or other images of Young People to be taken or used without the consent of the Parent / Guardian and the Young Player. The Club will take steps to ensure that these images are used solely for the purpose they are intended, which is the promotion and celebration of the Club's cricketing activities. If you become aware that these images are being used inappropriately you should inform the Club Welfare Officer immediately.

If photographs e.g. team or action shots, are submitted to the Press or published on the Club website individuals will not be identified. In circumstances where there is a need to identify an individual player in the Press parental permission will be sought beforehand

Youth members are welcome to other events in the club e.g. senior men's / lady's matches, but must be accompanied by an adult.

Any serious infringements of the above rules may result in the withdrawal of your child's membership without reimbursement of the subscription fee. However you should note the procedural requirements are to follow a verbal warning with a written warning and a record of the same shall be kept by the club.
